For the safety of yourself and others, you may consider delaying participation if you:

- Have recently traveled to "hot spot" areas of the country or have travelled internationally.
- Are unable to comply with your state's mandates for travel restrictions or quarantine after travel.
- Are in a higher risk category due to age or have pre-existing conditions such as: cardiovascular disease, respiratory disease (including asthma), diabetes, or are immunocompromised.

ASP recommends but does not currently require COVID-19 testing before participation with ASP. ASP recommends that those in vulnerable populations delay their participation until it is safe to be in public. If you need to delay your trip, please have your Trip Coordinator contact ASP's Volunteer Department ASAP.
